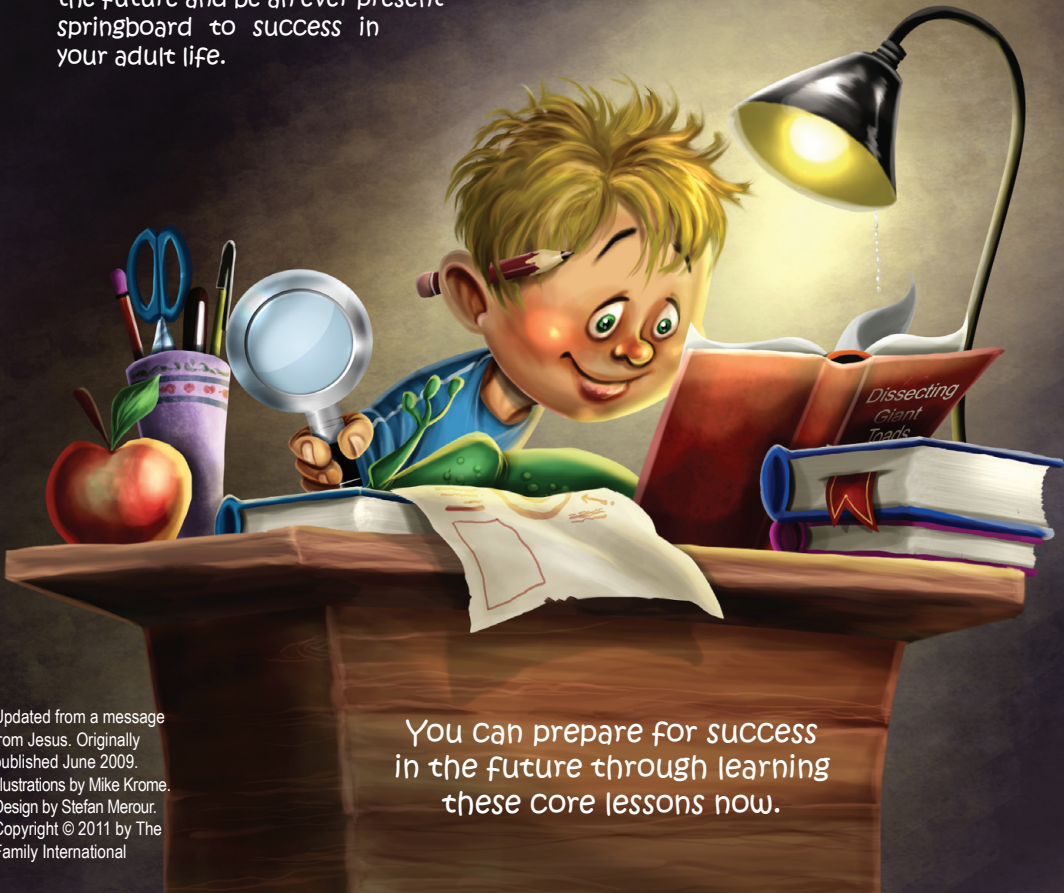


A 2-FOR-1 DEAL
